

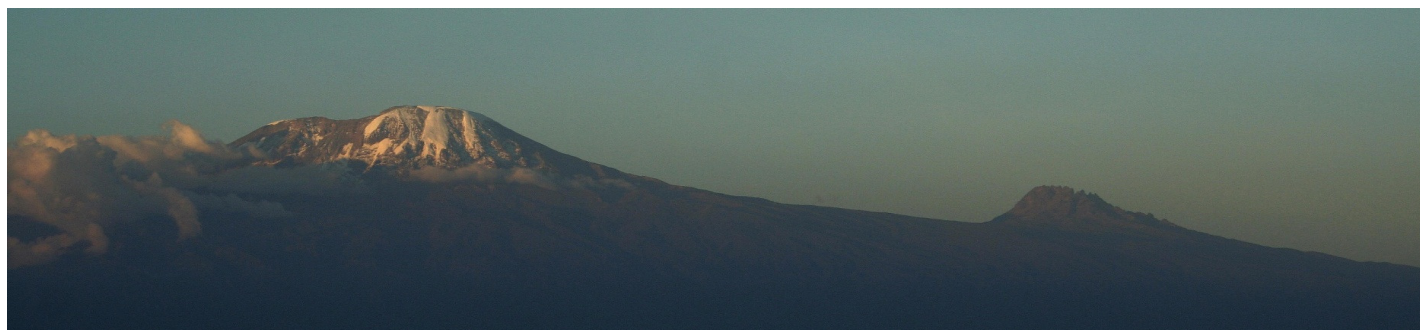

The Map's Edge outfits climbs through only a very few select operators, as we firmly believe that there are three principle guidelines in choosing a reputable mountain operator. Firstly, and most important, of all is your safety, second is your safety and third is your safety. There are a host of Cowboy outfits who can offer very cheap Kili Climbs but you will get precisely what you paid for. You have come a long way to climb this majestic mountain and our guess is that you actually want to reach the summit - yes? Don't look for a quick cheap climb that will save you a few bob as more than likely you won't make the summit. Slow down, relax, acclimatize and take that extra day or two – it will be oh so worth it when you are standing on Kibo under that battered old sign post. At least two nights in Arusha (at 4,500 feet) pre climb to help acclimatize is recommended. Please ask for full detailed, day by day, itineraries of the route that you are interested in, or 2011 rates.



**Included:** Return road transfer from Arusha to the mountain, Mountain Guide (with Wilderness First Aid Responder or Equivalent), Assistant Guide (with Red Cross First Aid Certified, Full board basis on mountain, Crew with Cook, Porters (carrying a max of 20kgs each), pup tents, walk in mess tent with tables and seats, pulse oximeter, supplementary oxygen, altitude sickness check lists, stocked first aid kit, evacuation stretcher, full trip briefing. Flying Doctors membership.

**Excluded:** International flights, Town accommodation pre or post climb, drinks & laundry, medical & travel insurance. Items of a personal nature. Gratuities to staff and porters. Any activities before or after the "In Pursuit of Oxygen".
